

Statement of Deficiencies

1725-A.-D.: Medication Management Training

Not Met

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- A. All staff members who administer medication shall have medication administration training.
- B. Whether administering medication or not, each early learning center shall have at least two staff members trained in medication administration.
- C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved Child Care Health Consultant.
- D. A licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.

Finding:

1725-A.-D. Based on record review/interview(s):

The provider did not have at least two staff members trained in medication administration whether the early learning center administers medication or not. S1 stated the center does not administer medication and she was unaware that two staff members needed to be trained in medication administration.

1901-G.-H.: Equipment

Not Met

- G. All equipment used by children shall be maintained in a clean and safe condition and in good repair.
- H. Moveable equipment shall be secured and supported so that it shall not fall or tip over.

Finding:

1901-G: Based on observation: All equipment used by children were not maintained in safe conditions as evidenced by Licensing specialists observed seven plastic toy trucks that were on the play yard for children to play with that could cause injuries with the jagged plastic edges.

1901-M: Strings and Cords

Not Met

1901-M: Strings and cords, including but not limited to those found on equipment, window coverings, televisions and radios, shall be inaccessible to children under age 4.

Finding:

1901-M Based on observations: Strings and cords were accessible to children under age 4 as S9's phone charger was hanging from the wall outlet in the classroom.

1901-P: Staff Personal Belongings

Not Met

1901-P: The personal belongings of center staff members shall be inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-P Based on observations: The personal belongings of center staff member S8's purse was on the floor in the classroom and accessible to the children.
