#### Findina:

7305.E. (5305.E.) The Provider lacked documentation of a current annual fire safety inspection and approval from the Office of State Fire Marshal.

### 5321-J: Daily Observation of Children

**Not Met** 

5321.J. Upon arrival at the center, each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises, injuries, physical condition, etc. When noted, results including an explanation from parent and/or child shall be documented.

#### Finding:

7321.j. (5321.J.) The provider did not document observations noted on children upon arrival to the center. Results including an explanation from parent and/or child were not documented. Ten of 40 entries did not have an explanation from parent and/or child.

5321-K: Incidents and Accidents

Not Met

5321.K. Incidents, injuries and accidents shall be documented. Documentation shall include name of child, date and time of incident, location where incident took place, description of how incident occurred, part of body involved, and actions taken. Documentation of all incidents/injuries/accidents shall include time of parental notification and signature of person notifying the parent. The parent or designated person shall be notified immediately in the following situations:

- -blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
- -head injury;
- -human bite which breaks the skin;
- -any animal bite;
- -an impaled object;
- -broken or dislodged teeth; or
- -any injury requiring professional medical attention.

## Finding:

7321.K (5321.K.) The Provider did not have documentation of immediate notification to the parent or designated person when the following occurred to a child: scratch near eye. Incident occurred at 11:50am on 9/16/09 and the parent was notified at 3:00pm.

5327-O: Fire Drills Not Met

5327.O. Fire drills shall be conducted at least once per month. These shall be conducted at various times of the day and night (if nighttime care is provided) and shall be documented. Documentation shall include:

- -date and time of drill;
- -number of children present;
- -amount of time to evacuate the center;
- -problems noted during drill and corrections noted; and
- -signatures (not initials) of staff present.

## Finding:

7307.O (5327.O.) The Provider did not have documentation on file that fire drills were conducted at least monthly at various times of the day and night (if nighttime care is provided). The last documented fire drill was10/13/09, but there was no documentaion of fire drills for 4/09, 8/09 and 9/09.
