

Statement of Deficiencies

1713-E&F: Supervision Participation

Not Met

1713-E&F:

E: While supervising a group of children, staff shall devote their time to supervising the children, meeting the needs of the children, and participating with them in their activities.

F: Staff duties that include cooking, housekeeping or administrative functions shall not interfere with the supervision of children.

Finding:

1713- E: Based on interview/recored review: While supervising a group of children, childcare staff did not devote their time to supervision of the children, as on 9/28/18 S3 had her back turned to the children she was supervising while she was at the changing table changing an infant's diaper. While S3 's back was turned, C2 was in her crib and was able to pull C1's rocker closer to the crib and scratched C1 in the face, breaking the skin. C1 had approximately four scratches in the face and redness to the eyes. C1's parents took C1 to the doctor due to the injuries.
