1713.G.: Restrooms

- 1. Children who are developmentally able may be permitted to go to the restroom independently at an early learning center, provided that:
- a. A staff member is in proximity to the children to ensure immediate intervention to safeguard a child from harm while in the restroom; and
- b. Individuals who are not staff members may not enter the center restroom area while in use by any child other than their own child.
- 2. A child age 4 and older may be permitted to go and return from the restroom without staff.

Finding:

1713.G. Based on record review/interview(s): On 7/31/19, at 9:28am, S17 allowed C1 to go and return from the restroom independently without staff as evidenced by S16 found C1 in the hallway spinning on his back alone. C1 did not return to class when leaving restroom. S1 documented, S17 thought there was a bathroom aide in the hallway, however S17 did not look before sending C1 to restroom.
