

Statement of Deficiencies

1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

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B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915-B.&C-Based on record review:

The center did not have documentation of incidents of incidents, injuries and/or accidents that occurred on the following days:

- 10/30/17 - a child was punched in the chest; a child was hit
- 11/08/17 - a child was hit in the face with a beanbag; a child was punched in the nose; a child was slapped on the arm
- 11/15/17 - a child was hit in the head by a thrown book; a child was punched in the nose;

The center did not have documentation of the time the incident occurred for the following;

- 10/31/17 - A child tripped and fell outside and scraped his head and hit his head
- 11/20/17 - a child fell and brush burned his right elbow

The center did not have documentation that a parent was notified by the end of the day for the following;

- a child fell on 11/08/17, parent signed on 11/09/17
- a child had a temperature of 101.5 at 12:45pm on 11/01/17, parent signed form on 11/14/17. There was no indication of when the child was picked up on 11/01/17.
