1717-A: Independent Contractors. The following information shall be maintained for all independent contractors, including but not limited to therapeutic professionals, extracurricular personnel, contracted transportation drivers, Department of Education, Office of Early Childhood staff and local school district staff:

- 1. an information form that includes the person's name, address and phone number
- 2. a list of duties performed while present at the center; and
- 3. documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check dated prior to the individual being present at the center or documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios that accompanied the contractor at all times while the contractor was on the center premises, to include the date, contractor arrival and departure time, language stating that the contractor was accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises, and the signature of both the contractor and the accompanying staff member.

## Finding:

1717-A: Based on interviews and record review: A contracted Pest Control person was at the center on 11/1/17, between 9:00am and 9:35am, and Center did not have documentation on file for an Independent Contractor that included the person's name, address, phone number, list of duties performed while at the center and documentation of a fingerprint based satisfactory criminal background check dated prior to the individual being present at the center or documentation of the paid, adult staff member not otherwise counted in child to staff ratios that accompanied the contractor at all times while the contractor was on the center premises, to include the date, contractor arrival and departure time, language stating that the contractor was accompanied by the staff member at all times while on the premises, and the signature of both the contractor and the accompanying staff member.

1903-C: Free of Hazards Not Met

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

## Finding:

1903-C:Based on interviews and record review: The center's indoor area was not free of hazards as evidenced on 11/1/17, between 9:00am and 9:35am, when a Pest Control person sprayed chemicals with children present at the early learning facility. According to a staff, 6 to 7 children ages 1 to 2 years old were in a class room at the time the Pest control person was spraying.
