

Statement of Deficiencies

1507-A: Daily Attendance Records - Children

Not Met

1507-A: A daily attendance record for children shall be maintained that shall:

1. include the child's first and last name, arrival and departure times, and first and last name of person or entity to whom the child is released;
2. accurately reflect children on the center premises at any given time; and
3. be used to sign in and out if a child leaves and returns to the center during the day.

Finding:

1507-A Based on observations/record review/interview(s): The center's daily attendance record for children did not accurately reflect the children on the child care premises at any given time as 74 children were present and 65 children were signed in on the log. Specialist observed that this was corrected prior to departure.

1907-E.2: Cribs Free of Toys and Other Soft or Loose Bedding

Not Met

1907-E.2: Cribs shall be free of toys and other soft or loose bedding, including comforters, blankets, sheets, bumper pads, pillows, stuffed animals and wedges when the child is in the crib.

Finding:

1907-E.2 Based on observations: The center's cribs were not free of loose bedding (including blankets) while the child was in the crib as evidenced by Specialist observed one child sleeping in a crib with a loose blanket.

1915-A: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915-A: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915-A Based on record review: Though center staff documented observations when something was observed, an explanation from parent and/or child was not documented.

1921-E: Tornado Drills

Not Met

1921-E: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:

1921-E Based on record review: The provider's documentation of Tornado drills was incomplete as the following was not noted: date and time of drill on the tornado drill complete in May 2017; and, there was no time documented on drill completed in April 2017. Specialist also found that there was no documentation of the March 2017 tornado drill. S1 stated that the drill was completed; however, she thinks that staff forgot to sign the form.
