1901-J.-K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901-J.-K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901-J.-K. Based on observations on 11/28/2018, items that could be harmful to children, failed to be kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensured that the children did not have access to those items. Specialist observed 3 cans of assured shaving cream, and 1 can of Barbosol shaving cream in an unlocked cabinet under the sink in S4's classroom. Specialist also observed a warming jar that was plugged in that had a liquid substance in it sitting on the cabinet in S4's classroom. The warming jar was warm to the touch and the liquid was hot. S1 unplugged the warming jar. Specialist also observed a roll of trash bags in an unlocked drawer in S4's classroom. Specialist observed in an unlocked drawer, 1 tube of Aveeno Baby lotion, 1 tube of Eucerin Baby cream, 1 tube of Aquphor diaper rash cream, 1 tube of Triple past medicated cream, 1 bottle of Neutrogena Beach defense sunscreen, 1 tube of Zinc Oxide Ointment, 1 bottle of Sunscreen lotion SpF45, 2 tubes of Boudreaux Buttpaste, 1 container of little Remedies/ saline spray, 2 tubes of Desitin, and 2 tubes of A&D Diaper Rash Creme in S6's classroom. Specialist also observed that S6 had 1 roll of clear trash bags in an unlocked drawer. Specialist observed 2 rolls of plastic bags in an unlocked drawer in S7's classroom. Specialist observed 1 tube of Aquaphor and 1 tube of Desitin in an unlocked drawer in S8's classroom. Specialist also observed 1 roll of trash bags in an unlocked drawer in S8's classroom. The items noted were observed to be in reaching distance of the children. S1 removed all items and made sure they were inaccessible to the children.
