Based on record review on 11/29/18, S1 did not have an employee file that included an application/staff information form to include name, date of birth, home address and phone number, training, work experience, educational background, hire date, upon termination or resignation of employment, the last date of employment, reason for leaving, for S2. S1 stated that S3 got sick and began throwing up on her and she asked her cousin to come in and assist her with the children. According to the staff attendance log S3 arrived at 7:00am and signed out at 9:15am. S2 left the center at 9:40 am after L/S advised that she could not be in the center without a proper CCCBC. S1 asked S2 to leave the center.
