

Statement of Deficiencies

1915.A.: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915.A.: Observation. Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915.A. Based on record review at 2:45pm, S1 failed to have documentation of an explanation from the parent and/or child when something is observed upon the child's arrival to the center for the following in classroom six:

- On 10/14/2020, a child had a scratch on the left side of nose
- On 10/15/2020, a child had a light scratch on right side of nose; a child had a scratch on face
- On 10/16/2020, a child had a scratch on face
- On 10/19/2020, a child had a scratch on nose; a child had a scratch on forehead
- On 10/20/2020, a child had a red mark on nose; a child had a small scratch on cheek
- On 10/21/2020, a child had a light bruise on nose

S1 stated classroom six is the infant classroom, and the teachers may be putting the explanations on the baby gram report.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 12/1/2020, S1 stated she will remind staff to document the explanation from the parent upon arrival on the daily observations log in addition to documenting it on the baby gram.
