S1 stated that the nine children where transported to school by local school bus.

1903-C Based on observations: The outdoor area was not free of hazards as specialist observed a rake on play ground that a child could use to harm themselves or another child with.

1909-G Based on observations: Specialist observed one infant sleeping while wearing a bib. The provider corrected during visit.

1911-G: Pacifier Attached

1911-G: Pacifiers attached to strings or ribbons shall not be placed around the neck or attached to the clothing of a child.

1911-G Based on observations: During specialist visit on 12/5/17, specialist observed 1 child with a pacifier attached to a string, attached to the clothing of a child in the toddler room.
