# Statement of Deficiencies

### 1507-B: Daily Attendance Records - Staff and Owners

1507-B: A daily attendance record for all staff members and owners shall be maintained that shall:

- 1. include the first and last name of the staff member or owner and arrival and departure times;
- 2. accurately reflect the staff members and owners on the center premises at any given time; and
- 3. be used to document staff members and owners who leave and return to the center during the day

#### Finding:

1507-B Based on record review: The center's daily attendance log reviewed failed to accurately reflect the staff present at the center on 12/5/17. S1, S2, and S3 were all present on the premises. S3 was the only staff signed in.

# 1711-A-B-D-G: Child to Staff Ratio

1711-A-B-D-G: A. Child to staff ratios are established to ensure the safety of all children.

- B. Minimum child to staff ratios shall be met at all times.
- 1. There shall be a minimum of two staff members present at an early learning center when more than one child is present.
- 2. Only those staff members directly providing care, supervision or guidance to children shall be counted in the child to staff ratios.
- D. Minimum Child to Staff Ratios for Type II and Type III centers:

- G. Mixed Age Groups Minimum Child to Staff Ratios
- 1. An average of the child to staff ratios may be applied to mixed age groups of children ages 2, 3, 4 and 5
- 2. Child to staff ratios for children under age two are excluded from averaging.
- 3. When a mixed age group includes children younger than age two, the age of the youngest child determines the child to staff ratio for the group.
- 4. An average may be applied to a mixed age group consisting only of children ages 5 and older.

# Finding:

1711-A-B-D-G Based on record review: On 12/5/17, Specialist was unable to establish that ratio was met as evidence by 1 staff(S3) was signed in at 5:40 am. The children started arriving at 6:13 am. There were no other staff signed in on 12/5/17. Specialist arrived at 1:45 pm and ratio was met. S1 and S2 were present.

# 1713-A&B&C: Supervision

1713-A&B&C: A: Children shall be supervised at all times in the center, on the playground, on field trips, on non-vehicular excursions, and during all water activities and water play activities.

B: Children shall not be left alone in any room, (except the restroom as indicated in Subsection G or when being provided services by therapeutic professionals as defined in 103), outdoors, or in vehicles, even momentarily, without staff present.

C: A staff person shall be assigned to supervise specific children whose names and whereabouts that staff person shall know and with whom the staff person shall be physically present. Staff shall be able to state how many children are in their care at all times.

#### Finding:

1713-A&B: Based on observation: Specialist while conducting the walk through on 12/5/17 with S1 observed that 4 infants who were in cribs were alone in the classroom. S2 was observed out in the hallway.

#### 1911-E: Daily Reports for Infants

1911-E: Daily Reports for Infants. Written reports that include the liquid intake, food intake, disposition, bowel movements and eating and sleeping patterns shall be given to the parents of infants on a daily basis. Reports shall be kept current throughout the day.

#### Finding:

1911-E Based on record review/interview(s):

The daily written report for infants was incomplete as it did not include all liquid intake for 2 infants and food intake for 2 infant, S1 stated that the infants
