

Statement of Deficiencies

1915-A: Health Services - Observation

Not Met

1915-A: Upon arrival at the center, the physical condition of each child shall be observed for possible signs of illness, infections, bruises or injuries, and when something is observed, it shall be documented and such documentation shall include an explanation from the parent or child.

Finding:

1915-A Based on record review and observations: S6, S3, S4 and S16 are not documenting an explanation from the parent or child on all documented observations of injury, illness, etc on a child. Also, S6 did not conduct observations of the children upon arrival at the center on 12/7/17. Specialist observed S6 conducting observations of the children in her classroom on 12/7/17, during specialist walk through of the center.

1915-B.&C: Health Services - Parental Notification

Not Met

1915-B.&C:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
2. head or neck or eye injury;
3. human bite that breaks the skin;
4. animal bite;
5. impaled object;
6. broken or dislodged teeth;
7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
8. unusual breathing;
9. symptoms of dehydration;
10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915-B.&C Based on record review: There was no documentation of immediate notification to the parents when the following incidents occurred: on 11/15/17 at 8:40am, a child took off her shoes, and some of other students were throwing the shoes around. A shoe hit another child on the nose and scratched the child's nose. Also, on 11/28/17 at 3:30pm, a child was scratched on the nose by another child on the play ground.
