1901-N: Strings and Cords

Not Met

1901-N: Strings and cords, including but not limited to those found on equipment, window coverings, televisions and radios, shall be inaccessible to children under age 4.

Finding:

1901-N Based on observations: Strings and cords were accessible to children under age 4. On 12/8/16 during inspection the Specialist observed in room #1 a computer desk with multiple cords and a power strip underneath the table there was nothing blocking the children's access to the cords or power strip. There were electrical sockets in the power strip that did not have socket cover on 3 of the 3 empty sockets. In room #2 there was a computer desk similar to room #1 with an orange power cord accessible to children underneath the table.

1903-C: Free of Hazards Not Met

1903-C: Indoor and outdoor areas shall be free of hazards.

Finding:

The outdoor area was not free of hazards as on 12/8/16 there were 2 storage buildings that were unlocked storage building which had chairs and other stacked equipment which is the hazard to the children. S1 stated that she had just left the storage buildings because she was making changes to a bulletin board. On the play yard there is a black plastic boarder around the play ground equipment which has cracks in the plastic and has sharp points from the breaks. The cracks in the plastic are a hazard for children. On the ramp coming from the play area there is a space between the two parts of the ramp which are a tripping hazard for the kids. On the same ramp there is a rusting nail which is assessable to the children. The nail seems to be part of the the previous structure which united the two pieces of ramp. Also on the play yard there is a broken Play School play house (beige, pink and green) which has an exposed sharp plastic screw which is a hazard to children.
