

## Statement of Deficiencies

### 1911.K.: Hand Washing

**Not Met**

1911.K.: Staff and children shall wash their hands using soap at least at the following times: upon arrival at the center, before preparing or serving meals, before giving medication, after playing in water used by more than one person, after toileting, after helping a child use a toilet or changing diapers, after wiping noses or cleaning wounds, after handling pets and other animals, after playing in sandboxes, before eating meals or snacks, upon coming in from outdoors, after cleaning or handling garbage and anytime hands become soiled with body fluids, such as urine, saliva, blood or nasal discharge.

#### Finding:

1911.K. Hand washing: Based on observations/interview on 12/8/2020 at 10:00am, Children did not wash their hands with soap and water as needed. Licensing Specialist observed S2 serving 5 one-year-olds morning snack after children had been playing in classroom. Specialist asked S2 prior to children eating if she was going to wash their hands. S2 responded, "I can". Specialist also observed a group of 11 two to four-year-olds eating morning snack. Specialist asked S1 where the children washed their hands since there is no sink in the room. S1 stated she used hand sanitizer.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 12/8/2020, S4 stated she will review with staff to send children over to the restroom to wash hands before meals and snacks. S4 stated that the staff know they need to and was not sure why they did not do so.

### 1919-D.3.&4.: Food Service and Nutrition - Reasonable Time and Food Served

**Not Met**

1919-D.3.&4.: 3. Children shall be allowed a reasonable time to eat each meal and snack. Children shall not be forced to finish all their food.  
4. Food shall be given to children on individual plates, cups, napkins, or paper towels, as appropriate, and individual utensils shall be provided, as appropriate.

#### Finding:

1919.D.4: Based on observations and interviews at 10:05am AM on 12/08/2020, children's food was not served on individual plates, cups, napkins or paper towels as Specialist observed three infants morning snack of Puffs served directly on the table with no barrier between the food and the table.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 12/08/2020, S4 stated she will talk to staff again about placing food on table tops. S4 will look into bowls with suction cups on bottom to use with the infants.
