A staff member who is a licensed practical nurse (LPN) or registered nurse (RN) with a valid nursing license shall be considered to have medication administration training.
- C. Such training shall be completed every two years with an approved child care health consultant.

Finding:

1725.A.-C. Based on record review/interview(s): During Specialist visit on 12/9/19 at 10:30am, Specialist reviewed files and observed that no staff had current documentation of training in medication administration completed with an approved Child Care Health Consultant. S1, S2, S3, and S4 medication training expired in August 2019. S1 stated that the center does not administer medication, however, she is aware that two staff members should have medication training. S1 stated that she is in the process of getting medication training for all staff.
