1901.J.&K.: Items That Can be Harmful to Children

Not Met

1901.J.&K.: J. Items that can be harmful to children, such as medications, poisons, cleaning supplies and chemicals, and equipment, tools, knives and other potentially dangerous utensils, shall kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that ensures they are inaccessible to children.

K. Plastic bags, when not in use, regardless of purpose or use, shall be made inaccessible to children.

Finding:

1901J.&K Based on observations on 12/10/2018, items that can be harmful to children were not kept in a locked cabinet or other secure place that would ensures that the items would be inaccessible to children. Specialist observed 1 container of Great value disinfectant, 1 can of ProLink Disinfectant Spray, and 2 rolls of plastic trash bags in a cabinet located under the sink that had a broken locking mechanism on the left side of the cabinet. The items would have been accessible to a child who opened the cabinet. All items were moved to the right side of the cabinet which had a working locking mechanism.

1919-D.3.&4.: Food Service and Nutrition - Reasonable Time and Food Served

1919-D.3.&4.: 3. Children shall be allowed a reasonable time to eat each meal and snack. Children shall not be forced to finish all their food.

4. Food shall be given to children on individual plates, cups, napkins, or paper towels, as appropriate, and individual utensils shall be provided, as appropriate.

Finding:

1919-D.4 Based on observations on 12/10/2018, Specialist observed the children in S3 and S8's classroom eating their morning snack(cheez-its) which was placed directly onto the table for the children to eat.
