1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

Not Met

1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in pediatric first aid through training approved by the department.

Finding:

****NEW**** 1723.C. Based on record review: S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 3 of 12 staff had documentation of this certification. S1 stated center staff took a course on 11/9/19 through the American Heart Association, but the course title reads on the card/certificate, Heartsaver CPR AED. This is not an approved course title for Pediatric First Aid.

Corrective Action Plan - S1 has contacted the instructor of the course to reissue the card with the proper title, as her staff took the Pediatric First Aid portion of the training.
