# Statement of Deficiencies

# 1723.A.&B.: CPR Certification

1723.A.&B.: A. Infant and child CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in infant and child CPR through training approved by the department.

B. Adult CPR. Fifty percent of staff members on the premises of a center and accessible to children, or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, shall have current certification in adult CPR through training approved by the department.

#### Finding:

1723.A&B.: CPR Certification. Based on record review/ observation at 1:30 PM: S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in infant and child CPR and Adult CPR through training approved by the department. 2 of 8 staff had documentation of this certification. Two additional trained staff are needed to meet this requirement.

CAP: S1 stated that she will schedule an Infant, Child and Adult CPR class for the remainder of her staff next month so that she can ensure that she will always have enough CPR certified staff present.

# 1723.C.: Pediatric First Aid

Based on record review/observation at 1:30 PM: S1 did not have documentation that at least fifty percent (50%) of all staff on the premises and accessible to the children or at least four staff on the premises and accessible to children, whichever is less, have current certification in Pediatric First Aid through training approved by the department. 2 of 8 staff had documentation of this certification. Two additional trained staff are needed to meet this requirement.

CAP: S1 stated that she will schedule a Pediatric First Aid class for the remainder of her staff next month so that she can ensure that she will always have enough First Aid staff present.
