7303-F: Within 24 hours or the next workday, the director shall notify the Bureau of the following reportable incidents. A verbal report is to be followed by a written report:

- 1. any death of a child while in the care of the provider;
- 2. any illness or injury requiring hospitalization or professional medical attention other than first aid of a child while in the care of the provider;
- 3. any fire;
- 4. any structural disaster;
- 5. any emergency situation that requires temporarily relocating children;
- 6. any unusual situation which affects the care of a child or children, e.g. child left unsupervised in the center, on the van, in play yard, on field trip, extended loss of power, water service, gas, etc.; or
- 7. any child leaving the center unsupervised or with an unauthorized person.

Finding:

Within 24 hours or the next workday, the director did not notify the Bureau of the following reportable incident: -Any illness or injury requiring hospitalization or professional medical attention other than first aid of a child While in the care of the provider: on 11/29/11, a child accidentally put wet oil based paint (at the child care center) on his face; his cheek became irritated and child had to be brought to the doctor.

7327-C: Construction Hazards Not Met

7327-C: 5327.C. Construction, remodeling, or alterations of structures shall be done in such a manner as to prevent hazards or unsafe conditions (fumes, dust, safety hazards).

Finding

The painting of child care center's rooms was not done in such a manner as to prevent hazards or unsafe conditions (fumes, dust, safety hazards) as evidenced by the painting of rooms during child care business hours. A room was being painted on 11/29/11 and a child got paint on his hands and left cheek, irritating his face. A room was also being painted today during child care operation hours.
