1915.B.&C.:

B. Reporting. Incidents, injuries, accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior shall be documented and reported to the parent no later than when the child is released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence.

C. Immediate Notification. The parent shall be immediately notified in the following circumstances:

- 1. blood not contained in an adhesive strip;
- 2. head or neck or eye injury;
- 3. human bite that breaks the skin;
- 4. animal bite;
- 5. impaled object;
- 6. broken or dislodged teeth;
- 7. allergic reaction skin changes (e.g. rash, spots, swelling, etc.);
- 8. unusual breathing;
- 9. symptoms of dehydration;
- 10. temperature reading over 101° oral, 102° rectal, or 100° axillary; or
- 11. injury or illness requiring professional medical attention.

Finding:

1915.B.&C.Based on record review at 11:03 am, S1 failed to have documentation of immediate notification to the parent when the following occurred to a child. On 10/21/2020, at 10:15 am, C1, a 3-year old, was pushed out of a chair, hitting the back of his head. On 12/10/2020, at 11:07 am, C3, a 1-year-old, hit her head on the table leave a red mark.

S1 failed to have documentation that incidents occurring in the center, not requiring immediate notification to parent, were reported no later than when the child was released to the parent or authorized representative on the day of the occurrence. On 12/8/2020, at 9:55 am, C2, an 11 month old, fingers were shut up in the door. On 12/11/2020, at 4:39 pm, C4, a 1-year -old, was bit by another child on his left hand, leaving a red mark. On the same day, at an unknown time, C4 was bit on his right arm. On 12/14/2020, at an unknown time, C5, a 3-year-old, hit himself in the right eye with a linking log. On 12/8/2020, at 2:30 pm, C6, a 1-year-old, was bit on her left hand.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 12/16/2020, S1 stated she will require teachers to notify her when an incident occurs. She will review all incidents and make immediate notification, via telephone, to parents as required by the regulation. Incidents that do not require immediate notification will be reported to the parent or authorized representative upon the child being picked up for the day. Parents will be asked to signed incident reports.
