1903.C. Based on observations at approximately 12:00pm *a hole with standing was located in play yard caused from building roof drainage which could result in a tripping hazard. ** part of fence in preschool play yard was torn down with a part of pipe exposed in play yard which could cause hazard to children.

Correction Action Plan: S1 states this will be reported to owners and the hole will be filled in. S1 reported a tree fell on fence which caused the damage and the fence is scheduled to be fixed by next week.

1921.E.: Tornado Drills

1921.E.: Tornado drills shall be conducted at least once per month in the months of March, April, May, and June at various times of the day necessary to include all children and shall be documented.

Finding:
