

## ***Statement of Deficiencies***

### **1917.D.: Medication Authorization - Non-Prescription Medication**

**Not Met**

1917.D.: If a non-prescription medication label reads "consult a physician", the early learning center shall also maintain a written authorization from a licensed health care provider for the child to take the medicine.

#### **Finding:**

1917.D.: Medication Authorization - Non-Prescription Medication: Based on record review: On 12/22/2020, Specialist reviewed C1's (18 months old) medication on file with the center, and observed S1 administered 3/4 tsp of Children's Dimetapp Cold and Cough on 11/17/2020 and 12/18/2020. The directions for use state, "do not use" for children under 6 years, and S1 did not have a written authorization from a licensed health care provider for C1 to take the medication.

Corrective Action Plan: Effective 12/22/2020, S1 will not administer non-prescription medication if not indicated for use with out written authorization from a health care provider, to ensure this deficiency is not recited.

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
