## Not Met

1919.A.&B.: A. All meals and snacks provided by the center, and their preparation, service and storage, shall meet the requirements for meals of the U. S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), 7 CFR 226.20, and LAC 51:XXIII.

- B. The weekly menu shall:
- 1. be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served;
- 2. be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week; and
- 3. have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu.

## Finding:

1919.B: Based on observations on 12/28/2018, S1 failed to have a weekly menu that shall be planned for each day of the week and list the specific food items served; be prominently posted by the first day of each week and remain posted throughout the week; and have substitutions or additions posted on or near the menu as evidenced by specialist did not observe a menu posted for the current week. Per S1's statement, since it was the end of the month she had been deciding day to day about meals so the center could use up food they had left and did not plan a menu. Specialist did observe a menu for the previous weeks.
